

1st August is Lammas Day, the traditional festival marking the beginning of the harvest.

People went to church to give thanks for the first corn to be cut and farmers donated bread

made from the first crop.

Farmers often gave their workers a present of a pair of gloves and in Exeter a large white glove was put on a long pole decorated with flowers to let the people know that Lammas had begun.

In some areas, the farmers would let the first corn bread go stale and then crumble it over the floor of their barns, to bring good luck.

"If the first week of August be warm, the winter will be white and long."
